

West Virginia is home to about 30 dairy farms

TOP STATES IN MILK PRODUCTION




West Virginia dairy industry economic impact

The total economic impact of dairy products produced and sold in West Virginia is **\$1.67 billion**, which generates **10,900 jobs** for West Virginians.


Nationally, the dairy industry creates more than 3.3 million U.S. jobs and has an overall economic impact of \$752.9 billion.
